# Japanese Lessons

日本語授業



- All classes put emphasis on communication skills.
1. Levels: 5 levels from beginners to the advanced
  2. Average Class Size : Around 10 (with 20 being maximum)  
Classes may include both general-Japanese-course students and summer-course students if their Japanese levels are the same.
  3. Class Hours : 8:50-12:10 (or 13:30-16:50)  
Some lessons may be temporarily held in the afternoon even if you are placed in a morning class.
  4. Certificate of Completion : a certificate of completion will be issued to students who obtain a good record of attendance and test results.
  5. Location: Takadanobaba (Tokyo)  
There are two school buildings in Takadanobaba.  
Since your class is determined according to the result of your placement test taken on the first day of the course, your school building will be decided for you. There is a possibility that your class may be moved to another school building in the middle of a course.  
Both school buildings are a seven-to-eight-minute walk from JR Takadanobaba Station.

## Application Procedures

1. Send a completed **Application for Admission**, an **Agreement Form**, and a copy of your passport to Sendagaya Japanese School by email, fax or postage. Applicants who are under 20 years old need to submit a **Parental Consent for the Participation of Minor** form as well. Our Japanese language courses are designed for people who are 18 years old and over. **Applications are accepted on a first-come-first-served basis and space is limited. Early application is encouraged.**
2. You will be contacted regarding your application. If accepted, you will be notified to transfer the course fee to our bank account.
3. After the remittance is confirmed, a certificate of admission will be sent to you.
  - \* Applicants are required to obtain an appropriate visa.
  - \* Applicants with the temporary visitor visa are required to purchase an overseas travel insurance in their home countries before arriving in Japan.
